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#### 6.2 Treasurer's Report

Kristina Marko

- Kristina comments on the extremely successful year Shepparton Show Me has had ending the 2018/19 financial year with a budget surplus of \$26,860.61
- Kristina adds the Shepparton Show Me committee is entrusted with a \$620,000 budget from Greater Shepparton City Council in its capacity as a Section 86 committee, to deliver the entire Shepparton Show Me marketing program which herself, the executive team and the wider committee manage to ensure Shepparton Show Me is on track
- The 2018/19 financial year saw the inclusion of the 2017/18 residual budget of approximately \$218,462.96, taking the total budget for 2018/19 to \$838,462.96.
- Approximately 71% of the budget is allocated to marketing, events and sponsorships so Shepparton Show Me can bring iconic events such as the Fryers Street Food Festival, Winter Fun Zone, Land of Plenty and the BMX Nationals to the region, stimulating economic growth and benefit to this regional city.
- Operational costs such as wages & on costs, truck maintenance, assets and insurance all come from the overarching budget which totalled \$811,602.35 leaving the budget surplus
- Whilst these funds were not fully utilised the appetite of the committee is one of value and efficiency. The committee worked hard to ensure the budget was accurately managed, providing the transparency and accountability not only to its members that it represents but also the wider community
